**Notes**

When setting the admission number consideration has been given to the net capacity assessment, pressure on places in a particular area and a primary school's ability to meet the requirements of the Infant Class Size legislation.

Note 1. The net capacity formula provides a maximum and minimum number of workplaces to guide the setting of the admission number. The LA must have regard to these limits in determining admission numbers. The formula produces an indicated admission number. It is permitted to set an admission number higher or lower than the indicated admission number.
